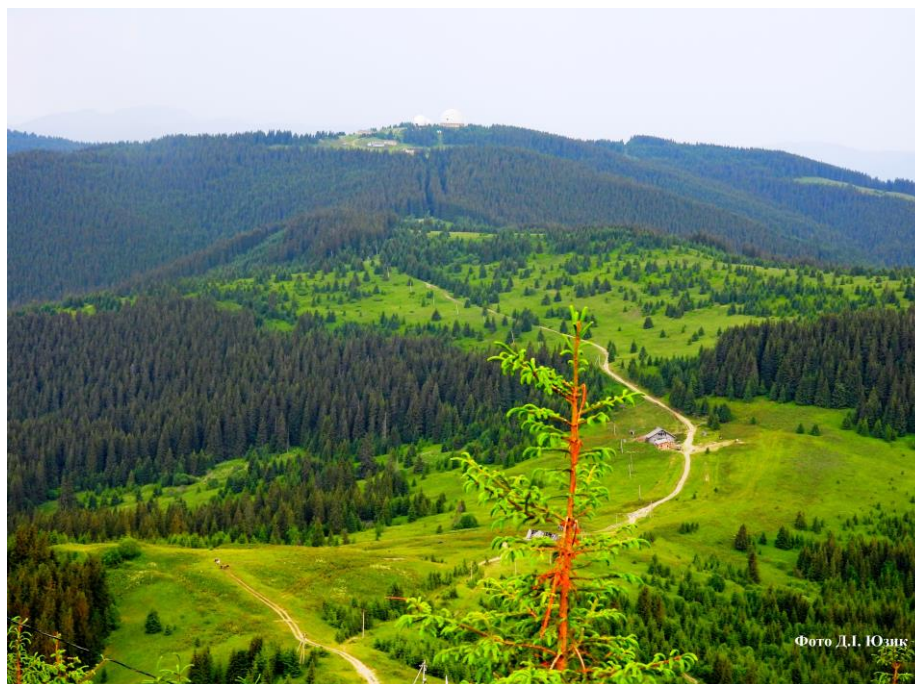

Conference languages: Ukrainian and English.

Forms of participation: direct participation (*oral report with presentation, poster presentation, participation without report*) and distance participation in online format (*broadcast of speeches in Google Meet, oral report with presentation, participation without report*). For correspondence participants of the conference materials will be sent by mail.

Main topics of the Conference:

- studying and protection the flora;
- studying and protection the fauna;
- studying and protection of geological objects;
- study and conservation of biodiversity in conditions of war;
- formation, functioning and use of natural museum collections and herbariums for nature conservation researches;
- application of GIS-technologies and SMART toolkit in natural studies;
- experience of nature conservation measures implementation, recommendations, management plans;
- problems of legal regulation of environmental practices in the context of countering threats of environmental and biological nature to national security of Ukraine;
- environmental education and modern issues of teaching methods of natural sciences;
- international scientific activity / cooperation in the field of protected affairs.

A printed collection of conference materials will be sent to participants who have paid the registration fee of the conference by Ukrposhta/Nova Poshta after the conference is over.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ABSTRACTS

Text of the abstract should be written in *Microsoft Word 97-2010*. The file name should contain the first author's surname in Latin (e. g., Yuzyk.doc).

Page format: **A4**

Number: up to **two** pages

Font: **Times New Roman**

Size: **12**, interval **1.0**

Fields: all – **2** cm, paragraph – **1** cm

Symbols: from the **Symbol** font

Alignment: the **width** of the page

Abstract Guidelines

- 1) Names of all the authors (bold letters, right alignment).
- 2) Institution, e-mails of authors (right alignment) .
- 3) Affiliations: Title (capital letters, size 14, bold, central alignment).
- 4) Affiliations: for abstracts in Ukrainian: title in English, size 14.
- 5) Affiliations: Summary (justified alignment, italics only for Latin names).
- 6) References should be given in parentheses, indicating the author's name and year of publication. References put at the end of the abstract, accordance with the rules for the compilation of bibliographic references DSTU 8302: 2015 of Ukraine.
- 7) Materials **may** contain tables, graphs or pictures (photos). **Do not** use text formatting. Send an **electronic** version of the abstracts at the organizing committee.

The Committee can reject materials that do not conform to the subject of the conference or are not presented according to the specified requirements; distribute reports by sections.

The registration fee will be refunded less shipping costs in case of rejection of abstracts.

Making a poster. The size of the poster should be 84.0x59.4 cm (format A-1) and contain: Surname and Name of the author (s), institution name, email of the author (s), title of the report. This information should be indicated at the top in accordance with the design of the abstract header.
